Emergency tarping

Tarping is a temporary cover over a damaged roof opening so rain does not keep pouring into the structure while a permanent repair is planned. This is a protection visit, not a full reroof.

Nailed-down tarping is the usual emergency cover on a shingle roof. Shrinkwrap tarping is for larger or irregular openings. Sandbag tarping is used when puncturing sound roofing would do more harm.

A tarp is not a finished roof. Leaving a tarp up for months without a follow-up scope is not a finished job.

Insurance Claim Help

Claim assistance is organized photos, written condition notes, and a repair-versus-replace explanation you can submit with your insurance claim. Warm Home Inc does not decide coverage. Your insurer does. You remain the policyholder.

Roofing, exterior, and interior

Roofing: inspect, explain repair-versus-replace, and provide a written scope before you decide. Systems include asphalt shingles, standing-seam metal, TPO, clay tile, aluminum, and liquid systems matched to climate, structure, and budget.

Exterior: siding, trim, fascia, soffit, and gutters that protect the walls and edges after weather or wear.

Interior: restore ceilings, walls, and finished rooms after water has already come in — once the leak path is controlled. We do not restore interiors while a leak is still active.
